Potato	Aphids—Green peach aphid (<i>Myzus persicae</i>), potato aphid (<i>Macrosiphum euphorbiae</i>); potato leafhopper (<i>Empoasca fabae</i>); potato psyllid (<i>Bactericera cockerelli</i>)
Rice	Green rice leafhopper (<i>Nephotettix cincticeps</i>); planthoppers—brown planthopper (<i>Nilaparvata lugens</i>), small brown planthopper (<i>Laodelphax striatellus</i>), white-backed planthopper (<i>Sogatella furcifera</i>); stink bugs
Soybean	Soybean aphid (<i>Aphis glycines</i>); stink bugs— <i>Edessa</i> species, <i>Euschistus</i> species, redbanded stink bug (<i>Piezodorus guildinii</i>), southern green stink bug (<i>Nezara viridula</i>)
Tree nuts and vines	Aphids—blackmargined aphid (<i>Monellia caryella</i>), black pecan aphid (<i>Melanocallis caryaefoliae</i>), yellow pecan aphid (<i>Monelliopsis pecanis</i>); grape leafhoppers (<i>Erythroneura</i> species); grape mealybug (<i>Pseudococcus maritimus</i>); walnut aphid (<i>Chromaphis juglandicola</i>)
Vegetables (cole)	Aphids—cabbage aphid (<i>Brevicoryne brassicae</i>), green peach aphid (<i>Myzus persicae</i>)
Vegetables (cucurbit)	Cotton/melon aphid (<i>Aphis gossypii</i>); whiteflies, <i>Bemisia</i> species, greenhouse whitefly (<i>Trialeurodes vaporariorum</i>)
Vegetables (fruiting)	Aphids—green peach aphid (<i>Myzus persicae</i>), potato aphid (<i>Macrosiphum euphorbiae</i>); whiteflies— <i>Bemisia</i> species, greenhouse whitefly (<i>Trialeurodes vaporariorum</i>)
Vegetables (leafy)	Aphids—foxtail aphid (<i>Aulacorthum solani</i>), green peach aphid (<i>Myzus persicae</i>), lettuce aphid (<i>Nasonovia ribisnigri</i>)
